1. 다음을 듣고, 남자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Good morning, students. This is your vice principal, Mr. Gunning. I have an announcement regarding our 'Spring Flower Photo Day' event this afternoon. As you know, we planned to take pictures of beautiful spring flowers as we walk around our neighborhood. I regret to inform you that the event is canceled due to heavy rain. I understand you've been looking forward to it, but unfortunately it appears we won't be able to get the best photos today. We will reschedule the event for a sunny day in the near future. Please understand that this decision was made to ensure that the event will be a success.
