1. 대화를 듣고, 남자의 마지막 말에 대한 여자의 응답으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Have you heard the actress Mary Jones is coming to our city's annual festival?
W: Really? I didn't hear that. She's one of my favorite actresses.
M: Same here. I'm going to go early to make sure I can see her in person.

W: Kevin, did you finish the article about the school cafeteria?
M: No, I didn't. I still have to summarize the survey on the students' opinions.
W: We don't have much time left to work on the next edition of the school newspaper.

3. 다음을 듣고, 여자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Good morning, class. As you know, our field trip is just around the corner. This will be the fourth year in a row I've taken students on a field trip. Every year, I choose two students to make a slide presentation with pictures taken during the trip. A few weeks after we return from the trip, we watch the presentation together and discuss our memories. If you want to volunteer to make the slide presentation, please let me know. If more than two students want to do the job, I'll choose two through an interview. This is a great opportunity for you to show off your skills of making a slide presentation. I hope many of you will show an interest in it.

4. 대화를 듣고, 남자의 의견으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Ms. Taylor, what is your opinion on Mr. Parker's open class today?
W: Honestly, I didn't like it.
M: What didn't you like about it?
W: The class was not efficient. The students read just one paragraph during the class.
M: You're right, but the class was based on a group activity.
W: I think that if students are taught in the conventional way, they can read many more paragraphs.
M: But, as you know, many students are passive and lose interest in lessons when teachers lead the class in the conventional way.
W: I know what you mean.
M: In Mr. Parker's class today, his students actively participated and learned through group work. I think it motivated everyone to learn.
W: I agree with you on that point. No one slept in the class.
M: Right. Students can surely learn through group work.

W: Oh, Ted. Would you have a seat here?

W: We'll finish editing the details of the book within a week and then pass the manuscript onto the print shop.
M: Then, how long before the book is released?
W: It might take about three weeks. I'm sure this will be one of our greatest fairy tale books.

M: Good. I see an elephant eating leaves off a tree.
W: It's cute, isn't it?
M: Yes, and I like the heart-shaped cushions on the bed, too. I can tell how much time and effort you have put into this room.
W: Thank you for saying so.

7. 대화를 듣고, 여자가 남자를 위해 할 일로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Deborah, what are you listening to?
W: Oh, I'm listening to some Jonathan Swift songs.
M: He's one of my favorite singers. Can I listen for a while?
W: Sure. Put these on. [Pause] Aren't his songs great?
M: Yeah. I think they sound much better because of these headphones. The sound quality is great.
W: You're right. These headphones improve the sound quality.
M: Actually, I've been thinking about buying new headphones lately, but I have no idea which ones to buy.
W: Do you mind if I ask what your budget is?
M: Not at all. I don't want to spend more than 150 dollars.
W: Great! I can recommend some models that would be just right for you. They offer great quality for their price.
M: That's what I want. And they are within my budget, right?
W: Of course. Let me show you what they are on the Internet.

W: Oh, I hope it is still there.

M: I'd like to buy some cosmetics for my wife. Your brand is one of my wife's favorites.
W: Good to hear that. What about this lotion set for skin? It's our most popular item these days. It's \$130 for a set.
M: Well, that's a little over my budget. Can I look at another set?
W: Sure. What about this one? It's \$100 for a set.
M: I'll take it. Would you also show me a lotion for men? It's for me.
W: Okay, sir. *[Pause]* How about this one? It's \$50.
M: Actually, that's the same kind that I'm currently using. I love the way it feels. I'll take it, too.
W: Do you have our membership card, sir?
M: Yes. Here you are. I can get a 10% discount, right?
W: Of course.
M: Here is my credit card.

W: No, there isn't. The contest is open to everyone.

M: Great. When is the deadline for entries?

W: It's May 31. All entries must be postmarked by May 30.

M: Okay. I heard the maximum length of a story is 1,500 words.

W: That's correct.

M: The first prize winner will receive \$500, right?

W: Yes. The second and third prize winners will receive \$300 and \$150, respectively. The winning stories will be published in our newspaper.

The total cost of the exchange trip is \$1,500 per student, which includes airfare. I hope this program will help you gain confidence in Spanish.

[16~17] 다음을 듣고, 물음에 답하십시오.

W: As an art teacher, I often notice that some children find it hard to paint their drawings because their drawings are very tiny. Unfortunately, this could lead to frustration, and even worse, indifference to art. So I thought over this problem and finally decided to make them stop using pencils in my classroom. The reason is practical: small pencil leads encourage small drawings. If children are drawing a portrait with a pencil and then are going to paint that portrait, it'll surely be a difficult task. For example, it's hard to paint tiny eyes! There is another reason. Pencil markings can be easily removed with an eraser. This could lead to frequent corrections, and the children could end the class without anything on their drawing paper. So I encourage my class to use markers instead. Using markers allows them to move quickly while forgiving their "mistakes" and not worrying about the details. My solution might not be the best one, but it works most of the time.
