1. 다음을 듣고, 남자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Hello, students. This is your vice principal, Mr. Smith. Our school is going to make a promotional video for future freshmen. It'll be a music video with students doing dances. The famous dance director, Kiera Turner, will help us. She'll be auditioning the applicants in the auditorium on Tuesday, October 25th. If you want to participate and show off your talents, just sign up using the QR code posted on the school bulletin board by this Friday. We'll upload the video on our school website after it's been completed, so please don't miss out on this wonderful opportunity to contribute to our school.

2. 대화를 듣고, 여자의 의견으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Owen, why are you massaging your neck?

M: Hey, Karen. My neck feels stiff.

W: That's too bad. When did it start?
