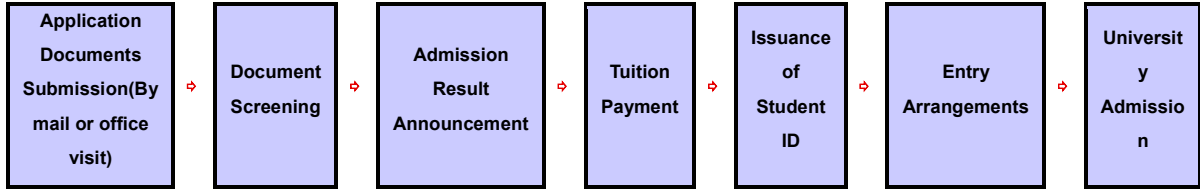

### III. Application Procedure



※ Applicants must submit all required documents by the deadline. Those who do not comply may be disadvantaged.

※ Non-qualified applicants shall be notified individually, and insufficient documents may be supplemented within the guided submission deadline.

※ All documents must be submitted to the Admissions Office either by post or in person.

## IV. Eligibility

### ① Citizenship & Academic Requirements

Freshman	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Nationality: Applicants with foreign nationality whose parents both have foreign nationality.</li> <li>2. Academic background: Applicants who graduated or are expected to graduate from high school.</li> <li>3. The applicant must complete regular primary and secondary education, equivalent to Grades 1 to 12 in the Korean education system, either in Korea or overseas.</li> </ol>
Transfer	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Nationality: Applicants with foreign nationality whose parents both have foreign nationality.</li> <li>2. Academic background :</li> <li>3. - Applicants who completed at least 2 years at a four-year university at home or abroad, earning all credits required to complete 4 or more semesters(65 or more credits)(excluding summer/winter session) and wish to transfer to the third year(junior) in the undergraduate program.</li> <li>4. - Applicants who went to community college must graduate from the school or must be on the list of candidates for graduation.</li> </ol> <p>– The students who completed (expected) at least 2 years at three-year of five-year university.</p>

※ If applicant and applicant's parent(s) have multiple citizenship including Korean citizenship, the applicant is not eligible to apply.

※ If applicants submit forged documents in regards to the eligibility requirements, the admission will be revoked, even if they have already been accepted.

### ② Language Proficiency Requirements

Please submit one of the following documents.

A. Korean	A score report of the Test of Proficiency in Korean(TOPIK) Level 2 or above : qualify for entering art and physical education department Level 3 or above : qualify for entering all departments
B. English	A score report for TOEFL 530(CBT 19, iBT 71)and higher or IELTS 5.5 and higher or CEFR B2 and higher or TEPS 600 and higher

## VIII. Scholarships for International Students

**(Students are not allowed to receive a scholarship with other on-campus scholarships)**

Gyeongju International Scholarship Program(GISP)

- A. Scholarship Period : Freshman 8 semesters / Transfer 4 semesters
- B. Requirement: Scholarship recipients must achieve a minimum 2.0 GPA each semester in order to retain their scholarship.
