W: This is Linda from "Life and Science." Did you know light pollution from bright lights at night can drive wildlife to death? For example, sea turtles lay eggs on beaches and their babies find their way to the sea with the help of moonlight. But artificial lights can confuse them and cause them not to reach the sea and die. Fireflies have been disappearing across the globe. Male fireflies get disturbed by artificial lights when they try to attract mates. This means less fireflies are born. Also, salmon migrate randomly when exposed to artificial lights at night. This threatens their chances of survival. Lastly, light pollution interrupts the mating calls of tree frogs at night. As male frogs reduce the number of their mating calls, the females don't reproduce. So light pollution can be a matter of life and death for some animals.
