

# 2019년 국가수준 학업성취도 평가

## 중학교 3학년 영어

지금부터 듣기 평가를 시작하겠습니다. 선다형 1번~15번과 서답형 1번~3번 문제는 듣고 푸는 문제입니다. 녹음 내용을 잘 듣고 물음에 답하기 바랍니다. 내용은 한 번만 들려줍니다.

**[1번]** 대화를 듣고, 여자가 구입할 수영 모자를 고르시오.

M: Hello, may I help you?

W: Yes, I'm looking for a swim cap for my daughter.

M: How about these with the pictures of strawberries or bananas on them?

W: Well, I don't think she'll like them.

M: Hmm.... Then, what about the swim cap with stars on it?

W: It's nice, but she likes animals. Are there any with animals?

M: Sure. Here, you have two options, one with rabbits and the other with dogs.

W: I think the swim cap with rabbits is better. I'll take it.

**[2번]** 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 대화하고 있는 장소로 가장 적절한 곳을 고르시오.

M: Mary, it's interesting to look at the stars with this observing device.

W: Right. This is a special building for studying the universe.

M: It's amazing. Is it always open to the public?

W: No, it's open only on weekends because this is where scientists study the stars and planets.

M: Oh, I see.

W: We're lucky. It's not cloudy today, so we can observe the moon so clearly.

M: Great!

**【3번】** 대화를 듣고, 여자의 심정으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Jenny, how are your paintings going?

W: Dad, look! I've finally finished my last painting.

M: Congratulations!

W: Thanks, Dad. I'm glad I can show all my paintings to everyone.

M: Me, too. I'm sure they'll love them.

W: I'm so excited! I can't wait!

M: It's going to be great. I'm so proud of you.

**【4번】** 다음을 듣고, Good Morning Music 행사에 관한 내용과 일치하지 않는 것을 고르시오.

W: Hello, students. You can enjoy this semester's Good Morning Music event on Thursday, of course, in the morning. It starts at 8 a.m. and finishes at 8:30 a.m. The performance will be at the school's main gate. The school band will play a variety of music. Also, the singing club will sing with the band. Please come on time and start your day with beautiful music. Thanks.

**【5번】** 대화를 듣고, 남자의 조언으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

*(Knocking sound)*

W: Mr. Smith. Can I come in?

M: Of course, Somin. What's up?

W: I want to read a lot of books this year. But it's not easy for me.

M: Oh, why is that? Did you choose books that are too difficult?

W: No, it's just hard to read books regularly.

M: I see. Then, why don't you join a reading club?

W: A reading club?

M: Yeah, if you join a reading club, members can help you to read more often.

W: Okay, I'll give it a try. Thank you, Mr. Smith.

**【6번】** 다음을 듣고, 무엇에 관한 내용인지 고르시오.

M: Good morning. This is an announcement from the student council. In order to help save the environment, our school has started a new campaign called "Clean Plate Day." We're going to set every Wednesday as the campaign day. The purpose of this new campaign is to reduce food waste. Please try to take only the amount of food you can finish. The school cafeteria will also prepare a special lunch menu. Thank you.

**【7번】** 대화를 듣고, 내용과 일치하지 않는 것을 고르시오.

M: Look at this poster. We're going to have Multicultural Day.

W: Yeah! It's on July 7th, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

M: It must be a big event. It's held at the school gym.

W: There're special activities. We can learn traditional dances from different countries.

M: Oh, I love dancing.

W: We can draw national flags, too.

M: That sounds fun. Look! We have to wear traditional clothing from other countries.

W: Right, it might be fun to see people wearing different clothing.

**【8번】** 대화를 듣고, 남자가 선생님을 찾아간 이유로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Good morning, Ms. Lee. Do you have a minute?

W: Sure, Brian. What brought you here today?

M: I came to sign up for the school invention contest.

W: Oh, I see. What's your invention about?

M: It's about a handy desk lamp.

W: Sounds interesting. Do you know you need to make a presentation for your invention?

M: Yes. I saw it on the poster and I've been working on it.

W: All right. Then, please fill out this form to sign up.

M: Okay. Thank you.

**【9번】** 대화를 듣고, 남자가 전화를 건 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

*(Telephone rings.)*

W: Good morning. This is Royal Theater. How may I help you?

M: Hi. I'm going to watch a musical this evening at 8. Is parking available?

W: Yes, but our parking lot is usually crowded around that time.

M: Really? Is there another parking lot nearby?

W: Yes, you can use the public parking lot across the street. It's free after 6 o'clock.

M: Perfect. Thank you for the information.

W: You're welcome.

**【10번】** 다음을 듣고, 남자가 한 일을 순서대로 배열한 것을 고르시오.

M: Last Wednesday was Parents' Day. After school, I came straight home and made some chocolate cookies. My parents like chocolate cookies. After baking, I went to the flower shop and bought some roses for my parents. When I got home, I wrote a thank-you note to them on a heart-shaped card. My parents read the card and were very touched. I was also happy to see them smile.

**【11번】** 다음을 듣고, 방송의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to our zoo. We have some exciting news for you. We have the most lovable newcomer, a baby panda. Her name is Fen-Fen. She's going to make her first public appearance today at 11:00 a.m. in the Animals of Asia section. She's the 5-month-old daughter of Jia-Jia and Chin-Chin. Come and join us to welcome this new panda family member.

**【12번】** 대화를 듣고, 여자의 마지막 말에 이어질 남자의 응답으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

*(Cell phone rings.)*

W: Hello? I'm calling to ask about the used guitar posted on the Internet.

M: Hi. What do you want to know?

W: How old is the guitar?

M: I bought it new a year ago, but I've rarely taken it out of its bag.

W: Oh, I see. Actually, I don't need the bag. Would you accept a lower price?

M: How much are you willing to pay?

W: How about 90,000 won?

M: That sounds fine.

W: Okay, I'll buy it. Can I come and get it today?

**【14번】** 다음을 듣고, 주어진 상황에서 할 말로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: You're waiting for the elevator to go up to the 8th floor. The door opens. When you step into the elevator, it's crowded with people. You're carrying a big box in your hands, so you can't press the button. You want to ask the man near the buttons to do it for you. In this situation, what would you say to this man?

**【15번】** 다음을 듣고, 남자가 주장하는 내용으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Every day we have so many things to do. But if you don't know where to start first, try to put those things in order by their importance. Here's how to do it. First, think about all of the activities you need to do. Then, write them down on a piece of paper. And rank the activities from most important to least important. Now you're ready to start.

**【서답형 1번】** 대화를 듣고, 빈칸에 적절한 말을 주어진 철자로 시작하여 한 단어로 쓰시오.

M: Hello, Ms. Jones. Can I sign up for the school festival audition?

W: Of course, Jihun. Are you going to participate as an individual or a group?

M: I'm going to participate by myself.

W: Okay. What are you going to perform?

M: I'm thinking of doing a magic show.

W: A magic show? Sounds great! I've never seen a student doing magic at the school festival.

**【서답형 2번】** 다음을 듣고, 질문에 대한 답이 되도록 빈칸에 적절한 말을 주어진 철자로 시작하여 한 단어로 쓰시오.

M: Do you want to have a happy life? Then, remember that happiness is based on how much we live in the present moment. One of the beautiful things about young children is that they live totally in the present moment. On the other hand, adults can think too much about future concerns. And they become stressed out about things they can't control. But we don't know what the future will be like. The present moment is all we have got. Live now.

W: Question. What does the man suggest to have a happy life?

**【서답형 3번】** 다음을 듣고, 여자가 말한 내용과 일치하도록 빈칸에 적절한 말을 주어진 철자로 시작하여 한 단어로 쓰시오.

W: Remember we all have a gift. Maybe you're really good at football, or maybe it's math. Or maybe you're really good at making friends. If you remember that you have a gift of something, you'll know you're special enough. When you're not satisfied with yourself, don't feel stressed. Instead, think about what your gift is. Say to yourself, "Even if I'm not perfect, I know I'm special because I have my own gift."
