ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번 다음을 듣고, 내일 아침의 날씨로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Welcome to the weather report. Today starts with bright sunshine. You won't find any clouds in the morning. However, in the evening, thick clouds will come from the west, and it will be cloudy. Tomorrow morning, there will be heavy rain, so don't forget your umbrella if you want to go out tomorrow.
