1번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 선택할 풍선을 고르시오.

M: Hello, how may I help you?

W: I'm looking for a balloon for my friend's birthday party.

M: We have flower-shaped and round-shaped balloons. Take a look at these samples.

W: I think the flower-shaped balloons are better because she really loves flowers.

M: Okay. We have balloons with a cake picture on them. Do you want the picture or not?
