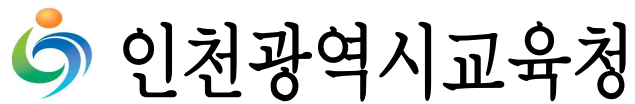

M: Last class, we talked in general about five essential nutrients. We'll look further into them individually. Today, let's talk about protein. Eating enough protein is necessary for your health, and it is available in various foods. Here is a list of high-protein foods and their benefits. Eggs are fairly high in quality animal proteins which reduce the risk of brain-related disorders, such as anxiety, nervousness, and fatigue. Chicken breast is also a good choice. This helps increase muscle mass and optimize bone health. Black rice has a high protein content, and it's effective in fighting against heart disease, cancer, and other diseases. Last but not least, we shouldn't take peanuts off the list. Eating peanuts daily decreases blood pressure, and it can lower the risk of weight gain. Now, you might be concerned about how much protein we should consume each day. Any ideas? Take a minute to think about it, and then we'll discuss it later.
