1. 다음을 듣고, 남자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Visitors, may I have your attention please? This is Anderson Thompson, manager of Benjiville Aquarium. W: Hello, students. Have you ever thought about what's happening in the insect world when it's raining? Today, we're going to talk about what insects do on a rainy day. Some insects come outside from their home. For example, cockroaches living in drains have to escape from there to survive when it rains. It's because their homes get flooded easily. They leave, so they will not drown. To give another example, mosquitos come out in the rain to lay eggs. Rainy days are the best time since newborn mosquitos need water to grow. However, other insects have to hide to stay alive. For instance, some types of ants hide themselves to get away from the rain because their body temperature drops when it rains. If they get cold during a rainy day, their bodies can freeze and they could die. Also, some kinds of flies go underground to avoid the rain. When their wings get wet, they can't fly, so they have to find some place to stay dry. As we can see, the rain affects various insects' behavior in different ways. Now, let's watch a video.
