1. 대화를 듣고, 여자의 마지막 말에 대한 남자의 응답으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Wow, look at that pink blouse over there!  
M: It's gorgeous. I think it'll suit you very well.  
W: Yeah, I like it. I hope they have my size.

2. 대화를 듣고, 남자의 마지막 말에 대한 여자의 응답으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Why did your computer suddenly shut down?

3. 다음을 듣고, 여자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Good afternoon, listeners. This is Sophie Brown from the Kingston Library. We always want to ensure our visitors comfort and convenience. As part of this effort, existing power transformers are being removed and new transformers are being installed. The whole project will last from August 5 to 28. The work will require full closure of the library on August 6, 13, 20, and 27, which are all Thursdays in August. The dates were chosen to minimize the inconvenience to visitors. For book returns on these days, use the drop box located on the first floor. These Thursday closures are in effect only in August. Thank you.

4. 다음을 듣고, 남자가 하는 말의 주제로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Hello, I'm Justin Wilson. Because I'm a vegetarian, people often ask me, "How do you get enough protein?" Many people believe that we can't get enough protein without consuming meat. However, most dieticians say that from plant-based diets we can not only obtain enough protein, but also reduce the side-effects of diets high in meat protein. So, dieticians suggest alternative protein sources such as soybeans, peas, and spinach to naturally balance the body's biochemistry and save energy wasted on digestion. This can lead to weight loss and efficient aging. Plant protein can also lower the rates of breast cancer. Consider a little change with an occasional meatless meal. Your body will experience new, healthier protein.

W: Wow! I can feel his love for his family and art.
