M: Hello, students. Last class, we discussed the harm caused by insects. Today, we're going to learn about the advantages that insects can bring us. First, honeybees play a crucial role in the reproductive process of plants by helping them to produce seeds. In the U.S., the honeybees' assistance in this process accounts for about \$20 billion in crops per year, including fruits and vegetables. Second, insects like grasshoppers are a major food source in the world because they're high in protein and low in cholesterol. In Mexico, for example, you can easily find fried grasshoppers sold in village markets. Next, silkworms are responsible for producing most of the world's silk, which is recognized as a valuable product. In China, silkworms produce approximately 30,000 tons of raw silk annually. Finally, fruit flies have been used by many researchers in genetic studies. Fruit flies are practical test subjects for such studies due to their short lifespan.
